

Volunteer Job Descriptions for First Impressions Team

Greeter: Greeters are needed to help welcome families, distribute programs, assist with check in and help new families and kids feel comfortable.

Runner: This position is for an individual that is willing to show guests where their children need to go for class. This is an extension of the greeting process and runners act as personal tour guides for the visiting families.

Golf Cart: The golf cart driver roams the parking lot looking for people to assist from their car to the front door of the church. During these quick drives this person greets and welcomes those individuals to our church.

Medical Team: This team member is available throughout the service to help with any kind of small or large medical emergency, until appropriate help can arrive. Medical training is a necessity for this team.

Parking Lot Assistance: This job includes guiding and directing families to parking spots available in our church parking lot.

Security: Team members on the security team make sure that all church members and their guest have a safe visit. Duties for this team would include surveillance of church parking lots, classrooms, worship center, and hallways.

Usher: This job involves collecting offerings, ballots, or other pieces of literature during our worship services.

Worship Center Greeter: Like the job of the greeter this person is specifically greeting and having conversations with individuals who are in our worship center. The goal is that the greeter can make connections between church visitors and the members around them.
